## **Multiple Board, Commission, and Committee Appointive Terms Expire December 2016 – We Have Many Seats to Fill!**

Rohnert Park City Council is requesting applications for appointment to:

The **Bicycle Advisory Committee** reviews bike path plans/projects and makes recommendations to City Council. Committee meets the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of every month at 5:30pm.

The **Mobile Home Parks Rent Appeals Board** works towards preventing unreasonable rent increases for controlled mobile home rental spaces in Rohnert Park while still assuring the owner's right to a fair return. The board currently meets on the 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of each month at 6pm.

The **Parks & Recreation Commission** reviews policies and programs and makes recommendations to City Council and Recreation Department. Meets the 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of every month at 6pm.

The **Planning Commission** reviews plans for physical development for proposed construction in the City. Commission meets the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of each month at 6pm.

The **Senior Citizens Advisory Committee** helps in identifying the needs and creating awareness of the elderly in the community. Meets at 1pm on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of January, May, and September.

The **Sister Cities Relations Committee** shares that people of all ages are basically alike and have common interests whatever their language, culture, or color of their skin and that the desire for peace is universal and the interest in learning from one another is widespread. Committee meets on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of each month at 7pm.
